Small Offerings
Philippians 1:3-6

1. Think of an example you've seen or heard of where someone did something small that had a big positive impact. Share it. What might have happened if that person hadn't been faithful to share their gift?
2. We talked about how the Philippians themselves were an example of God's faithfulness to Paul while He was in prison. Turn to Acts 16:11-15 and read what you find there.

Was this a person who someone like Paul would normally associate with? Why or why not?

We talked about people doing small things that made big impacts. Where have you seen God work through unexpected people to make big impacts?

3. In our passage, we see Paul reminding people about God's faithfulness & power: The same God who created the universe and everything in it is the same God who is even now being faithful in you and I.

Do you believe this?

Are there difficult or challenging circumstances in your life right now where you need to be reminded of God's incredible faithfulness? What are they?

Are there difficult or challenging circumstances in the lives or circumstances of others where a small gift or action you might take could have a big impact?

What are you waiting for?

4. Spend some time together praying for anything that was shared in response to #3. Pray specifically that we would remember what kind of God we serve, and that HE is working, even now, in US!
